Toronto Commercial Real Estate Women ("Toronto CREW") is a business development network for women involved in a broad cross section of disciplines in the commercial real estate industry. Toronto CREW was the



first international chapter of the US based CREW NETWORK, whose mandate is to facilitate communication and interaction among senior real estate

In order to support young women pursuing careers in the real estate field, Toronto CREW offers a number of CDN \$3,000 scholarships to female students enrolled in approved degree programs specializing in commercial real estate. Scholarships have been granted in past years to students at Queen's University,

York University, Ryerson University and Guelph University. In 2008, seven scholarships were available. It is anticipated that the number of scholarships to be awarded will increase in future years.

In addition to receiving a monetary



award, scholarship recipients will automatically be accepted for participation in the Toronto CREW mentor-

ship program once they are working in the commercial real estate field. The Mentorship program assists recent commercial realty new-comers by pairing them with experienced mentors who can impart the benefit of their industry guidance and know how.

Scholarship Eligibility

Applicants must be in their third to last year of an undergraduate or graduate real estate program approved by Toronto CREW. For certain twelve (12) month Masters' programs, students apply in their second term.

Requirements

1. Female
2. Demonstrated interest in pursuing a career in Canadian commercial real estate
3. Superior academic achievement
4. Demonstrated community involvement
5. Resident of Canada

Application Deadline

February 28, of the relevant year of enrolment.

University Tuition

Scholarship funds will be utilized to pay tuition for the final year (and in some cases, semester) of the recipient's degree program.
